2. PM 2.5 Implementation Update

To provide increased public health protection EPA revised the 24-hour National Ambient Air Quality Standard for fine particulate matter (PM2.5) in 2006, reducing the level of the standard from 65 ug/m3 to 35 ug/m3. Monitored PM2.5 design values in much of Iowa are 75% or more of this revised standard. This presentation will outline the challenges of regulating PM2.5 and the steps that Iowa is taking to implement the revised standard.
