

# ADVANCED SAFETY CERTIFICATE



## *What is the National Safety Council's Advanced Safety Certificate?*

This Certificate helps you maximize your effectiveness as a safety professional and leader while targeting the technical and management safety skills you want to develop. Learn to use your knowledge of best practices to take your safety program to a new and more powerful level. The core courses in this Certificate program give you a solid foundation of knowledge to meet all your safety challenges and assist you in stepping out on a path towards greater accomplishment and recognition. In order to attain the Advanced Safety Certificate, you must complete the POSH course and a minimum of 5.4 CEUs among the approved classes. ### ***Principles of Occupational Safety and Health (POSH)***

Do you have the responsibility of managing safety and health at your company? Then this is the course for you. This course is designed to give you knowledge of safety practices, safety terminology and the skills needed to implement a comprehensive safety process in your organization. You will also learn techniques to identify hazards and take specific actions to prevent incidents and learn how to develop and implement a proactive and preventive safety plan.

You'll go beyond the basics of compliance and learn best practices to help prevent injuries and related costs. When you complete this course, you'll be able to complete your safety responsibilities with confidence and get positive, measurable results. Additionally, this course lays the foundation for achieving your Advanced Safety Certificate.

### ***Safety Management Techniques (SMT)***

Designed for the safety leader, this course meets the needs of safety and health committee leaders, supervisors, and middle/upper managers. You'll learn how to lead safety in your organization, and get your team involved in safety and health efforts. The course will also teach you how to identify the fundamental principles of safety management and how to create an action plan to improve the safety management in your company.

### ***Fundamentals of Industrial Hygiene (FIH)***

If you are a safety, health and/or environmental professional or manager who has industrial hygiene responsibilities but limited training or experience in this area, attend the Fundamentals of Industrial Hygiene course. This course develops your understanding of industrial hygiene terminology, principles and practices by examining four key processes in an effective industrial hygiene effort -- anticipation, recognition, evaluation, and control. Discussions on when to use a qualified/certified industrial hygienist are held throughout the course.

### ***Safety Training Methods (STM)***

If you are a manager, supervisor, human resource representative, or employee who is responsible for the planning, development and/or delivery of safety and health training programs, attend the Safety Training Methods course. This course is a challenging and interactive learning experience. Combined with information, numerous group and independent learning activities provide opportunities to apply newly learned concepts to a variety of safety and health training scenarios. You will learn how to calculate direct and indirect training costs, complete a training needs analysis and design a training program applicable to your work environment.
