



Safety Checklist

Warehouse Pedestrian Safety

Keep pedestrians safe at your warehouse

Follow these steps to protect pedestrians and reduce forklift injuries at your worksite:

- ✓ Remind all employees that they need to be aware of their surroundings at all times
- ✓ Train forklift operators in the proper use of their vehicles and how to avoid striking pedestrians
- ✓ Perform regular inspections of lift trucks to detect any defects in steering, brakes, horn or backup alarms
- ✓ Whenever possible separate pedestrians from lift trucks by providing separate pedestrian walkways with railings or other protective barriers
- ✓ Install convex mirrors at blind aisle intersections
- ✓ Keep aisles and passageways clear

Be sure all materials are handled and stored safely:

- ✓ Store all chemicals according to the manufacturer's recommendations
- ✓ Loads of materials should be stacked evenly, with heavier loads on lower or middle shelves
- ✓ Bags and bundles should be stored in tiers of limited height to prevent tipping
