Course time is spent learning and practicing adult training techniques. Students will participate in the development and delivery of lectures covering construction safety topics during class. Prerequisite: participants must provide verification of 510 class attendance, and management confirmation of at least 5 years of relevant safety experience ·CLASS DATES: October 11-14, 2016

OSHA 501 Trainer Course for Gen. Industry

Course time is spent learning and practicing adult training techniques. Students will participate in the development and delivery of lectures covering general industry safety topics during class. Prerequisite: participants must provide 511 class attendance verification and management confirmation of at least 5 years of relevant safety experience. •CLASS DATES: November 29 - December 2, 2016

OSHA 502 Update for Const. Industry **Outreach Trainers**

This course is designed for Outreach Training Program trainers who have completed OSHA #500 Trainer Course in Occupational Safety and Health Standards for the Construction Industry and are authorized trainers in the OSHA Outreach Training Program. The course provides an update on OSHA Construction Standards, policies, and regulations. Upon course completion students will have the ability to demonstrate continued professional development in their field by applying effective adult learning principles and interactive training techniques to clearly identify, define, and explain construction industry hazards and acceptable corrective measures as they continue to teach the 10- and 30-hour Construction Outreach Training Program classes. Prerequisite: OSHA #500 Trainers Course in OSHA Standards for the Construction Industry. Authorized Outreach Training Program trainers are required to attend this course once every four years (4) to maintain their trainer status. Authorized Outreach Training Program trainers are required to attend this course once every four (4) years to maintain their trainer status.
